Shanghai Old Street

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Located in Fangbang Middle Road (from Renmin Road to Henan Road), it is 825 m long and consists of two parts—the eastern part and the western part. The eastern part is characterized by local dwelling houses in the architectural style of the late Qing Dynasty, and the western part is comprised of stores and workshops with an air of great antiquity.

Old City Wall and Dajing Tower

It is the only extant city wall of the Ming Dynasty. In order to fight against Japanese pirates, in the 32nd year (1553) of the reign of Emperor Jiajing in the Ming Dynasty, people built the 4.5-kilometer-long

and 8-meter-high city wall of Shanghai County in only three months. The whole city wall was pulled down in 1912 except for a nearly 50-meter-long section for the sake of the Dajing Tower standing on it. Now the tower has become a witness to

Sanshan Guild Hall

It was first built in the first year (1909) of the reign of Xuantong in the Qing Dynasty by Fujian fruit merchants in Shanghai. The guild hall is elaborate and resplendent. Inside there is a stage, which is decorated with patterns of the eight city wall gates of the old city of Shanghai.

Shuyin Tower

Being the most complete ancient building extant in the old city area of Shanghai, it is a court residence built

during the reign (1736-1795) of Qianlong in the Qing Dynasty with the floor area of over 1,000 sq m. The building is decorated with carved and painted beams, pillars and bricks.

Dianchun Hall

Located in the northeastern part of Yuyuan Garden, it is a magnificent building with five halls. Xiaodao Association held a military uprising in the third year (1853) of the reign of Xianfeng in the Qing Dynasty, who broke into Shanghai County and set up the commanding office in Dianchun Hall. Now such historical articles as weapons, currency and documents used then are on display here.
